INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The HB&T Large Cap Core Index Fund is invested in a pooled collective fund managed by Barclays Global Investors (BGI) and is structured to produce returns that are consistent with the S&P 500 Index. The Index Fund attempts to duplicate the investment performance of the S&P 500 by owning all of the 500 common stocks appropriately weighted and represented by the S&P 500 Index.

Index Description

The S&P 500 Index is a capitalization-weighted index consisting of approximately 500 Large Cap domestic companies. The S&P 500 Index is a blend of both growth and value oriented companies with no particular bias given to either style. Component companies are adjusted for available float and must meet objective criteria for inclusion to the index. Reconstitution for the index is annual.
