## INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The HB&T Small Cap Blend Index Fund is invested in a pooled collective fund managed by Barclays Global Investors (BGI) and is structured to produce returns that are consistent with the Russell 2000 Index. The Index Fund attempts to duplicate the investment performance of the Russell 2000 by owning all of the 2000 common stocks appropriately weighted and represented by the Russell 2000 Index.

## Index Description

The Russell 2000 Index is a capitalization-weighted index consisting of approximately 2000 Small Cap domestic companies. The Russell 2000 Index is a blend of both growth and value oriented companies with no particular bias given to either style. Component companies are adjusted for available float and must meet objective criteria for inclusion to the index. Reconstitution for the index is annual.
